ABOUT THE EVERY COMPANY

The EVERY Company, headquartered in the San Francisco Bay Area, is a market leader in engineering, manufacturing and formulating animal-free, animal proteins as ingredients for the global food and beverage industry. Originally founded as Clara Foods in 2014, EVERY™ rebranded in 2021 to better convey its vision to bring animal-free proteins to everyone, everywhere. EVERY™ is a team of passionate changemakers who are reimagining the factory farm model with a more sustainable and kinder alternative. Leveraging precision fermentation to produce super-functional and one-to-one replacement proteins from microorganisms, EVERY™ is on a mission to decouple the world's proteins from the animals that make them.

WHAT WE DO

We make real animal proteins without using a single animal — starting with the world's first animal-free egg proteins and the world's first [animal-free porcine pepsin](#). Our method of brewing proteins using fermenters and yeast instead of factory farms and animals requires far less water, land, energy and greenhouse gas emissions. Similar to the process of making rennet for cheese (a protein ingredient found in 80-90% of store bought cheeses in the United States), we take the same DNA sequence that would be found in an animal protein and insert it into yeast. We feed the yeast sugar, which then naturally converts into protein. The end result is nature-equivalent protein, made without using a single animal. Our final animal-free protein product contains no sugar and no genetically modified organisms.

Our proprietary precision fermentation technology allows us to produce very pure proteins that match or surpass the texture, taste and culinary functionality of animal-derived counterparts -- ensuring the highest-quality and most consistent version of an egg protein every time.
